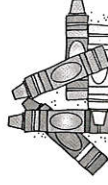

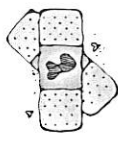
Attention all outgoing 5th Graders

All students entering 6th grade are required to have one Tdap vaccine per Colorado State Law. Your child may be denied entry into school if they do not have the required immunizations. Just a reminder, if your child has a personal or religious exemption for immunizations required by Colorado State Law, a new exemption will need to be completed after July 1, 2018. Learning and the Brain

Ideas for Creating a Growth Mindset Environment at Home Part 6:

- Talk about neural networking. Ask your child what he or she has learned at school about the brain.
- Whenever you hear your child say "I give up" or "I just don't get this," remind your child to visualize neurons connecting every time he learned something new. Encourage your child to work hard in practice new skills and concepts like he will develop strong neural connections and his brain.
- Share with your child some things that you have not yet mastered and your plan for practicing and building stronger connections in your brain
